Did you know that plants have feelings that can be sonified?

Beaconsfield Gallery Vauxhall is offering unique sonic workshops in June for local schools, that expand the way we relate to sound. Relates to both science and art curricula. Suitable for 14+.

Working with international sound artists Trevor Mathison and Gary Stewart of Dubmorphology, the sessions are based in Beaconsfield's new electronic sound studio: BEMS+V. Students will explore infrasonic sound by listening to the architecture of the building and the organic flora and fauna of the gallery garden, before engaging in collaborative sound composition.
