Willow you walk withy me? 2025 Willow and other plants, action, 31 May 2025, 3-5pm

Tamsin Pender has been invited to share her recent practice of wreath-making with willow stems (otherwise known as 'withy') when walking in nature: a practical response to grief. In her playful contribution to *Manifesto for Sustainable Experimentation* the artist invites visitors to the opening celebration 'Willow You Walk Withy Me?' – to walk, gather and weave withies and found-plant material from the next-door plant nursery Urban Oasis, into wreaths, in a gentle practice that investigates loss, resilience and unloosing. Wreaths are chain-linked together and remain in the space for the duration of the exhibition.

Tamsin Pender is a multidisciplinary artist and educator who has exhibited at Tate St Ives As Dark As Light (1999) and Wallsall New Art Gallery Girl (2000) and created learning and participation experiences for the Southbank Centre. She was an early collaborator at Nosepaint 5 June 1993, and over the last 30 years has been commissioned by Beaconsfield for Glean, 66-28 June 1998 and Chronic Epoch 1995-2005, 14 September-20 November 2005, and exhibited in Fraternise - The Salon, 2 April-29 May 2011.



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
